Warning Signs & Red Flags

- Telling you that you can never do anything right
- Jealousy of friends and time spent away
- Isolating you from your friends
- Using put-downs in front of others
- Controlling your money
- Acting in ways that scare you
- Intimidating you with guns, knives, etc...
- Controlling where you go, who you see, cell phone
- Preventing you from making your own decisions
- Preventing you from working or attending school
- Destroying your property
- Threatening to hurt your pets
- Telling you that you are a bad parent
- Threatening to harm or take away your kids
- Pressuring you to use drugs or alcohol
- Pressuring you to have sex or do things sexually that you are uncomfortable with
